These volumes will provide introductions to, translations of, and commentaries on the various written and epigraphical genres of chronographical writing in Latin, starting with the chronicles of Cornelius Nepos and Pomponius Atticus. We are currently completing volume one, which covers the history of non-Latin chronicles, early written and epigraphic Latin chronicles and consularia, and the late Roman flowering of the consularia genre from the third to the sixth centuries. The following volumes will cover the well-known Latin chronicles from Jerome to Cassiodorus. A small paperback volume of short introductions and translations will follow.
